

Reading Plus Cross Reference to the Australian Curriculum

Based on current version of Curriculum as of 9 January 2021

Reading Plus is designed for both Primary School and High School students, with an appropriate interface and content for each student body. High School students of all years for advancement, remediation, ESL Students and advanced Primary School students from year 3 onwards. Students must have foundational English in place prior to starting this programme.

Reading Plus develops 27 areas of reading comprehension, reading fluency, reading efficiency, vocabulary, writing, visual memory and correct ocular scanning.

See Reader has two parts: Independent Reading and Guided Reading and branches between both as required as well as branches up and down in difficulty dependent on student response.
